- Regional News bulletins are broadcast at 0655, 0755 with 30" headlines broadcast at 0734 and 0839, average duration of 2'00" to 5'00" in duration.
- Local Weather is broadcast every half hour, and during these times if needed will include temperatures of localities within our license area plan, we also broadcast rain readings when we have inclement weather. The Capital City forecast is broadcast at 06.36am each weekday.
- Rural News is re-broadcast at 0615 with the duration approximately 6 minutes.
- Local Stock Market report is broadcast at 06.20 Tuesday and Fridays.
- Funeral announcements are broadcast weekdays at 0725, these can average from 1 x 30" to 10+ 30" announcements, with some approaching 45".
- Locally produced On This Day segments run daily at 0745.
- Sponsored Lotto/Oz Lotto/Powerball results broadcast 0545 and 0815 daily.
- Sponsored Health Check segment broadcast at 0845 approx run time 60".

Weekdays (Monday through Friday) 09.00 - 11.00 is on Relay and non local except for commercial break insertion.

Weekdays (Monday through Friday) 11.00 - 14.00

- National News hourly
- Regional News bulletins are broadcast at 11.07, 12.10 and 13.00 average duration of 2'00" to 5'00".
- Local Weather is broadcast every hour, which includes temperatures of localities within our license area plan, we also broadcast rain readings when we have inclement weather.
- Rural News is re-broadcast at 12.35 with the duration approximately 6 minutes.
- Funeral announcements are broadcast weekdays at 13.27, these can average from 1 x 30" to 10+ 30" announcements, with some approaching 45".
